

- 4. Part of Honda's unique ventilation system. Fresh air is taken in from the front, mixes with warm air from the heater, and – after de-misting the back window – emerges from louvres at back.
- Back seat passengers ride in comfort. Heavily padded interior sprung seats. Plenty of leg room. Rear windows which open at the bottom to let air in. Keep rain out. Big side pockets take the inevitable odds and ends.
- Roomy boot. (Spare wheel is stored under bonnet to make extra room). Back seat folds flat when necessary to house bulky articles.


HONDA MATTIC

When Honda goes automatic, the same sort of detailed thought that goes into every one of the 'N' series, makes it utterly reliable, safe and efficient.

The Hondamatic is a fully automatic transmission with an over riding manual control on the three gear ratios. The shift lever quadrant has seven positions, P-R-N-D-3-2-1, and is mounted on the steering column. The reverse, neutral and drive positions of the shift are for automatic driving. First, second and third positions can be manually selected and held, if you prefer.

Honda's fully automatic-cum-manual transmission is specially made for people who enjoy ease of driving, yet like to be able to select gears when peak performance is required.
