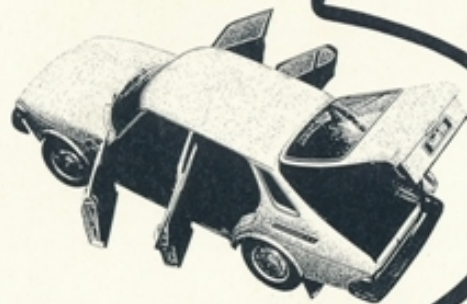




**The Saab 99 GL Combi Coupé** **5** **doors**



# **A new Saab 99 Combi Coupé with 5 doors – and many other merits.**

When first presented, the Saab 99 Combi Coupé aroused widespread and justifiable interest.

Mainly because it was a roomy and easy-to-load estate car—but with the sporty styling of a coupé model. And without compromising on any of the traditional Saab comfort.

It also attracted those whose transport requirements were greater than a conventional car could accommodate, but who considered the traditional estate car to be unnecessarily large, heavy and often van-like inside.

The 3-door Saab 99 Combi Coupé became a great success. It is now joined by

a 5-door version which can be easily identified by the number of doors and the characteristic opera-coupé windows.

The rear side doors make it easier for the back seat passengers to get in and out of the car. And the large load-carrying area is now even easier to load and unload through the rear side doors. Easier to stow away whatever you wish to carry. And easier to get at it.

The principle behind the Saab 99 Combi Coupé is certainly worth a practical trial. You may find more advantages in the 5-door version than we can list. Particularly if you consider comfort important.

## **The 5-door Saab 99 GL Combi Coupé**



When long and bulky items are to be transported, the back seat and backrest can be folded forward—easily, simply and without tools. You can then carry items up to 1.84 metres long. And the capacity is no less than 1500 dm<sup>3</sup>. The maximum height of the luggage compartment is 92 cm. The front of the luggage compartment is also easy to reach through the rear side doors.



The parcel shelf can easily be removed and stowed away in the luggage compartment. This increases the height of the luggage compartment to 80 cm. When the parcel shelf is removed, the luggage compartment offers ample space for the pram body, the family dog or whatever else you wish to keep an eye on. The capacity of the luggage compartment with the parcel shelf removed is 381 dm<sup>3</sup> to SAE standards. And an extra compartment at the extreme rear offers a further 90 dm<sup>3</sup>. This extra compartment is provided with a lid, and is thus suitable for stowing away whatever you wish to remain invisible from outside.



The regular luggage compartment is roomy and easy to load. The floor is 119 cm long. The height from the floor to the parcel shelf is 45 cm. The height of the parcel shelf from the ground is 53 cm. The luggage compartment has no rear sill. The rubber-covered bumper serves as a practical support when loading heavier goods. The headroom below the open rear door is 180 cm. The parcel shelf is level with the top edge of the rear backrest and is designed to absorb the noise from the luggage compartment. And it also neatly encloses the luggage compartment.

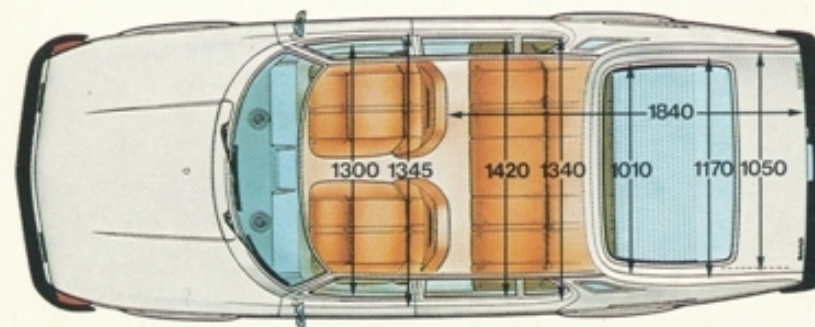
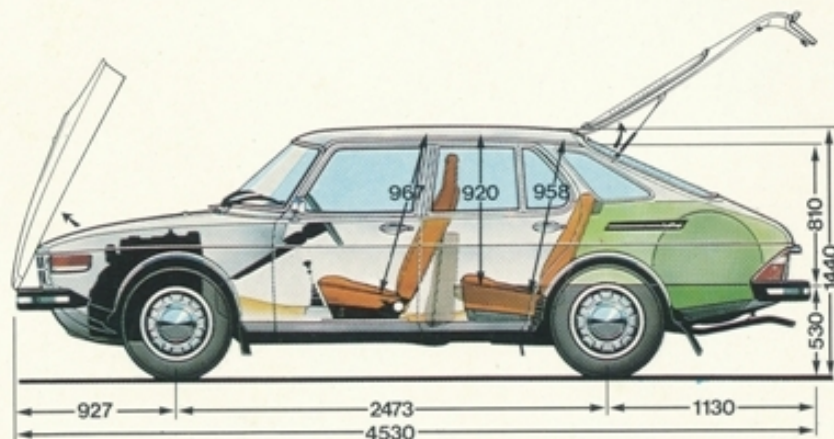
