EQUIPMENT IN A MODERN AMBULANCE

Helping the injured and sick has become one of society's most important activities. Modern technology and advanced know-how have made it possible to extend this assistance away from the hospitals. An ambulance is no longer only a vehicle but a complete care unit which can be sent to an injured or sick person for immediate treatment at the site of the accident or at home.

The prevailing Northern, almost Arctic, conditions in Finland have always imposed special demands on operations outside the hospital. The same holds true with the hard tropical conditions of the South. Ambulances must have a good and effective air-conditioning system to meet these requirements.

With the help of a team of experts Tamro has researched and compiled factors that are important for the success of the treatment carried out in the ambulance, for safe emergency driving and to facilitate working in the ambulance. Our technical staff has used this data for large-scale planning and finally handed over the actual building of the vehicle to our skilled auto body workers. The result is a high-class Tamro ambulance which has caused worldwide interest.





IS FIRST CLASS

To have enough room and all equipment within reach and ready for use is important. The treatment equipment and medical supplies are located in the wall-to-ceiling set of cabinets on the left side in the patient section. First aid bags are kept in the cabinet above the driver's cab.

The patient compartment has been raised so that the staff can work in standing position, it also gives more room and comfortable working environment for several people in a small space.

Tamro ambulance has an efficient lighting system. Four 100 W general lights in the ceiling, a smaller light bulb in a set of cabinets and a manually or mechanically operated 100 W spotlight in the ceiling. Small lights


around both doors always turn on when the doors are opened.

The complete version of the Tamro ambulance has a comprehensive range of equipment: anaesthesia apparatus, respirator, oxygen- and suction systems, ECG-monitoring and defibrillator devices. There is available in all Tamro ambulances a vacuum stretcher, vacuum splints, dressing material, blankets, a lifting sheet, straps, etc.

Sturdy and multi-purpose chairs facilitate the work of the staff.

The stretcher trolley and stretchers can be moved sideways so that depending on the situation the staff can work on whatever side of the patient necessary.
